



THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGING COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order at 2:00pm by Chairman Milligan.

Present were members Karl Milligan, Chairman, Connie Loureiro, Jane Vezeris, Dave Stevens and Tom Beery. There were no members of the general public present.

- A motion was made by Mr. Stevens and seconded by Ms. Vezeris to approve the January minutes and the day's agenda. It was unanimously approved.
- At 2:05 pm, a motion to go in to closed session was made by Mr. Beery to discuss case # 24-13 and 25-03 under § 3-305 (b). It was seconded by Mr. Stevens and unanimously approved.
- At 2:35 pm, the committee came back into open session. Chairman Milligan stated that the committee had reached a decision on case 24-13, and it would be forwarded to the agency, officer and complainant. It also determined that case 25-03 would be returned to the agency, because an active police officer was not identified in the complaint.
- Chair Milligan reported that he had a recent discussion on requirements of PAB and ACC boards for background checks and confidentiality oaths and agreements. A short discussion followed.
- Chair Milligan also advised that the county had rejected a mileage request from one of our Trial Board members for a hearing held in Baltimore County that involved an incident occurring in Queen Anne's County. A short discussion followed on sending any of our Trial Board members out the county. On a motion by Mr. Stevens and seconded by Ms. Vezeris, we will not ask a Trial Board member to travel outside of Queen Anne's County. It was unanimously approved. A short roundtable discussion followed on procedures for complaints that do not identify or misidentify a specific police officer.
- Chair Milligan reported that there are three pending investigations at agencies, and that we should have one before our next monthly meeting.

At 3:05 pm, A motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Vezeris and seconded by Ms. Loureiro, and it was unanimously approved.
