- Bike to school, Fall event (October 1, 2025).
  - Kyle reviewed plan to hold event at Centreville Middle School.
  - Discussed additional meetings to be held with Town Sherrif, School Board, PTA, and Principle regarding event logistics and safety.
  - Discussed possible options to source a Bike Rack for the school via funding options (school, grant, public, salvage). Bike rack would complement schools recent investment in new sidewalks (Safe Routes To School)
  - Team available to assist Kyle in future meetings as needed.
- QAC Trail Web Presence
  - Bob and Nick reviewed meeting held with Tourism Advisory Board on 4/8/25 to improve web presence
  - Shared existing Tourism brochures highlighting Cross Island and South Trail including maps.
  - Suggested refresh of existing “On Road” trail routes and enhancing web communication via GIS downloadable routes. Team could update routes to highlight Tourism opportunities.
  - Next Steps is April Plummer meeting with Steve Chandlee to align on strategy and appropriate team structure for refreshing “on road” trail routes.
