General Items Discussed or Shared:

- Reviewed previous meeting Action Register.
- Bike to school, Fall event (October 1, 2025).
 - Kyle updated team on evolving location and activity
 - Decided will not be bound to national Walk, Bike to School Day.
 - Discussed objectives are twofold: 1) encourage youth participation in walking or biking to school and 2) educating youth on bike transportation safety. Event in fall could focus on both or perhaps just #2 if decide to focus on elementary youth.
 - Kyle to continue to have discussions with school personnel on options and will keep team informed if opportunities develop. Bob to work on identifying State MDOT contact for Safety info/materials
 - Team is available to assist Kyle as she defines the event.
- QAC Trail Web Presence
 - Bob reviewed process he and Nick are pursuing to “refresh” the QAC On-Road trails.
 - Once completed will approach April Plummer from Tourism Advisory Board in Oct/Nov. on next steps.
 - Vision is to a) verify safety, parking, comfort level of on road routes b) identify additional tourism promotion opportunities, c) confirm route’s visual interest/effort levels and d) enhance web presence via updated On Road Maps with latest GIS and QR code downloadable route maps.

 - Steve provided update on South Trail connectivity phases III and IV as well as traffic light installation at Rt 8 crossing.
