

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-03

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Definition of “Winery” under Chapter 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County, Maryland;

FOR THE PURPOSE of defining the term “Winery” as used in Chapter 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws;

BY ADDING a definition of Winery to Chapter 18 App of the Code of Public Local Laws.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 18 App-1. Definitions of Chapter 18 App of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended as follows:

*Chapter 18 App
Appendix A: Glossary*

§18App-1. Definitions.

...

WINERY – a part of producing vineyard. Wineries include crushing, fermenting, blending, aging, storage, administrative office functions for the winery, warehousing and shipping facilities. Retails sales and tasting facilities of wine and related promotional items shall be permitted as part of the winery operations. Planned promotional event or other organized activity as permitted under Article 2B §2-205 as amended of the Annotated Code of Maryland are included in this definition.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
