

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-14

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to Chapter 27 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County entitled “Human Resources”;

FOR THE PURPOSE of revising and updating the provisions on Human Resources in the Code of Public Local Laws; clarifying certain provisions relating to disciplinary action; revising and clarifying that certain time periods shall be based upon business days; correcting typographical errors; providing that certain appeals from personnel decisions shall be in writing; providing that certain human resources conferences may be conducted by the designee of the Director of Human Resources; providing for the matters and actions which may be appealed to the Queen Anne’s County Personnel Board; revising and clarifying the purpose of Personnel Board hearings; revising the provisions on frequency of meetings and rules of procedure for the Personnel Board; repealing the provisions permitting health insurance coverage for certain contractual workers; and generally revising, clarifying and updating the Queen Anne’s County Human Resources Ordinance, Chapter 27 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County;

BY AMENDING Sections 27-102, 27-105, 27-106, 27-108, 27-110, 27-111, 27-113, 27-114, 27-115 and 27-116 and BY REPEALING Section 27-124 E. (2) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Sections 27-102, 27-105, 27-106, 27-108, 27-110, 27-111, 27-113, 27-114, 27-115 and 27-116 of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as set forth on the attached.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that Section 27-124 E. (2) of the Code of Public Local Laws be and is hereby REPEALED.

SECTION III

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
