

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-27

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services Impact Fees within the Grasonville (District No. 2) Subarea;

FOR THE PURPOSE of eliminating the allocation of fire protection and emergency services impact fee revenue between fire protection and emergency medical services;

BY AMENDING Section 18:3-18.B. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 18:3-18.B. of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as follows:

§18:3-18. Fire protection and emergency medical services impact fee service area.

A. The applicable service areas for imposition of a fire protection and emergency medical services impact fee is the entire County, including all municipal corporations.

B. Except as provided by §18:3-12, the fire protection and emergency medical services impact fee shall be collected and applied in accordance with the Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services Impact Fee Subarea Map. ~~Impact fee revenues collected within the Grasonville, District No. 2 subarea shall be accounted for and allocated equally between fire protection and emergency medical services.~~

SECTION II

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
