

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on August 14, 2012, Commissioner Dumenil introduced County Ordinance No. 12-05, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Historic Structures and Historic Structure Review; FOR THE PURPOSE of removing the requirement for a recommendation from the Heritage Coordinator in connection with certain development applications involving historic structures and revising the definition of "Historic Structure" to apply to buildings equal or greater than 100 years of age; BY AMENDING Section 18:1-19 and the definition of "Historic Structure" in Chapter 18 App-1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

The Planning Commission made a favorable recommendation with respect to the proposed amendment.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, September 25, 2012 at 6:20 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.
