

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 11-15

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING Special Registrations Required under Chapter 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws;

FOR THE PURPOSE of authorizing the Queen Anne’s County Plumbing Board to establish and impose a fee for registration under Section 12-10 of the Code of Public Local Laws; providing that persons holding a master plumbers license be exempt from such fees; and clarifying the applicability of registration requirements under Section 12-10.

BY AMENDING Section 12-10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne’s County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 12-10 of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as follows:

§12-10. Special registrations.

A. Registration required; exception.

- (1) A person may not install any appliance, HVAC system, water conditioner, pump or make a propane gas connection without a County registration.**
- (2) This section does not apply to a ~~person holding a County master plumber license or to~~ a homeowner who installs an appliance other than a gas appliance in or on the homeowner’s property.**

B. Application. A person desiring a registration under this section shall apply to the Board.

C. Application requirements. An application for a registration must be accompanied by:

- (1) A current State of Maryland master well driller’s license, a State of Maryland water conditioner installer’s license, State of Maryland gas fitter’s license, ~~or~~ State of Maryland pump**

installer's license, or State of Maryland HVAC license.

- (2) A certificate of insurance in form and amount as prescribed by the Board.
- (3) Unless the applicant holds a County Master plumber license, such fee for registration as may be established by the Board from time to time.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
