At their regular meeting held on June 9, 2020, Commissioner J. Wilson introduced County Ordinance No. 20-09, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Carry Over of Vacation Leave; FOR THE PURPOSE of revising the amount of vacation leave that may be carried over from calendar year to calendar year from 520 to 600 hours; BY AMENDING Section 27-91 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.
