THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 13-15

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, §17-1006 requires certain individuals doing business as a junk dealer or scrap metal processor in the State of Maryland be licensed to engage in said business; and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, §17-1003 requires that a county or municipal governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held shall designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records in accordance with the statute.

WHEREAS, similar provisions in Title 12 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article apply to dealers in second hand precious metal objects and pawnbrokers.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion made, duly seconded and carried, it is this 10th day of September, 2013, RESOLVED, by the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, Maryland, as follows:

1. That the Maryland State Police is hereby designated in the place and stead of the Queen Anne's County Sheriff's Department as the Primary Law Enforcement Unit for Queen Anne's County in regards to the enforcement of the regulations as set forth in Title 17, Subtitle 10 and Title 12 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.

2. That the Maryland State Police shall receive records in accordance with §12-304 and §17-1011(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.

Finally, IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the 15th day of September, 2013.
