

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on September 27, 2011, Commissioner Dumenil introduced County Ordinance No. 11-22, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance, Chapter 28 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. FOR THE PURPOSE of revising and updating the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance of Queen Anne's County; deleting obsolete references therein; clarifying the definition of "Development Proposal"; requiring a determination of adequacy of schools for residential developments of 20 or more new lots or units; providing for concurrent submittal and review of APF applications and development applications at the option and risk of the developer; revising the level of service standards for schools and for transportation facilities; and generally revising and updating Chapter 28 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County. BY AMENDING Sections 28-2, 28-3, 28-4, 28-5, 28-7 and 28-8 of the Code of Public Local Laws.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, October 25, 2011 at 6:25 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.
