

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on June 8, 2010, Commissioner Fordonski introduced County Ordinance No. 10-09, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING the Establishment of a Program to Encourage Energy Efficiency Improvements and Renewable Energy Production Equipment; FOR THE PURPOSE of establishing a Clean Energy Loan Program as authorized under Article 24, Section 9-1501 through 9-1507 of the Annotated Code of Maryland; providing for eligibility and use of funds lent under the program; providing for repayment thereof and the priority of same and the collection thereof in the same manner as County real estate taxes; establishing a revolving loan fund, requiring an annual report; permitting third party contracts; generally dealing with an establishing a Clean Energy Loan Program in Queen Anne's County, Maryland and providing that the same shall be emergency legislation and effective immediately upon adoption. BY ADOPTING a new Chapter 14:6 entitled Clean Energy Loan Program as a part of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.
