**ARTIFICIAL TURF RULES & REGULATIONS
KENT ISLAND HIGH SCHOOL / QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL**

Any use of the field requires a "Use Permit" obtainable from the Queen Anne's County Department of Parks and Recreation. Please call 410-758-0835 to obtain a permit application or for any further information.

The maintenance and life of this field depends on the proper use and care of the facility. Therefore, the following activities are **NOT** permitted on the Artificial Turf Fields:

- a. Spike or indentation made into the turf surface from goals, tents, umbrellas, and banners.
 - b. Marking materials such as paint, chalk, flour, or any other marking substances.
 - c. Food, including sunflower seeds, gum, or beverages, except water
 - d. Glass containers
 - e. Alcohol
 - f. Smoking, barbecues, fireworks, or any type of open flames
 - g. Animals, including dogs
 - h. Cars, bicycles, scooters, or moving vehicles (except for maintenance and emergency)
 - i. Metal cleats
 - j. Golf, shot putting, javelin, or disc throwing
 - k. Use of duct tape or any type of adhesive
 - l. Unauthorized use of model planes, rockets, and drones
- Prior approval by the Queen Anne's County Department of Parks and Recreation is required for all structures, including goals, tents, umbrellas, and banners.
 - Sport equipment must be lifted when moved. No dragging of equipment is allowed.
 - All users must present a valid turf use permit before using the field.
