

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 09-27

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Composition of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board;

FOR THE PURPOSE of providing that one member of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board shall not be connected with the building and plumbing trade and that one member may be appointed without regard to trade or association; and declaring the same to be an emergency bill;

BY AMENDING Section 12-2 B.(2) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 12-2 B.(2) of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE II

County Plumbing Board; Plumbing Inspector

§12-2. County Plumbing Board.

...

B. Membership; qualifications. [Amended 10-19-2004 by Ord. No. 04-39]

- (1) The Board shall consist of seven members who are residents of Queen Anne's County.**
- (2) The Board shall consist of:**
 - (a) A representative of the Master Plumbers Association of Queen Anne's County;**
 - (b) A person holding a master plumber license in the County who is recommended by, but need not be a member of, the Master Plumbers Association of Queen Anne's County;**
 - (c) A person employed in the building or construction industry and who is not a plumber; and**
 - (d) One person not connected with plumbing or the building trade.**
 - (e) Two persons who hold a current Maryland HVACR**

- contractors license.
- (f) One other person whose qualifications shall be in the discretion of the County Commissioners.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill shall be passed as an emergency Bill and shall take effect from the date of its passage.
