

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 07-02

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Establishment of Legislative Days for the Enactment of Local Laws in Queen Anne's County, Maryland;

FOR THE PURPOSE of establishing the second, third and fourth Tuesdays of each month as legislative days for the enactment of local laws.

BY ADDING Section 4-4 A. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 4-4 A. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County be amended to read as follows:

§ 4-4. Meetings; special legislative sessions.

A. In general. The County Commissioners may meet on the second, third and fourth Tuesdays of each month to enact local laws.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Bill shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its passage.

Description:

This ordinance is for the purpose of establishing the second, third and fourth Tuesdays of each month as legislative days for the enactment of local laws.
