

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 06-23

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the applicability of the Queen Anne's County Ethics Ordinance Chapter 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County;

FOR THE PURPOSE of clarifying the boards and commissions, officials and employees subject to the provisions of the Queen Anne's County Ethics Ordinance.

BY AMENDING, Section 8-5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 8-5 of the Code of Public Local Laws be amended as follows:

§ 8-5. **Applicability.**

The provisions of this chapter ~~shall be applicable~~ apply as follows:

C. Boards and commissions.

- (1) Members of the following boards and commissions ~~shall be~~ are subject to the provisions of this chapter:

Agricultural Preservation Board  
Animal Control Commission  
Board of Appeals  
Bay Bridge Airport Commission  
Board of Building Appeals  
Advisory Board of Recreation and Parks  
Board of Electrical Examiners  
Ethics Commission  
Plumbing Board  
Queen Anne's County Housing Authority  
Kent Narrows Development Foundation  
Board of Directors  
Board of Liquor License Commissions  
Queen Anne's County Planning Commission

- (2) Any Members of any other board or commission which ~~may be determined by the Ethics Commission to have decisionmaking~~ that has decision-making authority are subject to the provisions of this chapter.

E. Queen Anne's County officials and employees.

In addition to the officials and employees, and members of boards and commissions identified in Subsections A, B and C of this section, all other officials and employees of Queen Anne's County, Maryland, ~~who have decisionmaking authority~~ and all members of other County boards and commissions ~~which have advisory authority~~ shall be subject to the provisions of § 8-11, Conflicts of interest, and § 8-12, Gifts, of this chapter.

## SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Bill shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its passage.
