

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 05-29

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Number of Consumer Representatives on the Queen Anne s County Department Of Emergency Services Advisory Council.

FOR THE PURPOSE of increasing the membership of the Queen Anne s County Department Of Emergency Services Advisory Council from eleven (11) to thirteen (13) and increasing the number of consumer representatives on the Queen Anne s County Department Of Emergency Services Advisory Council from one (1) to three (3).;

BY AMENDING Section 21-12B(2) and (B) (2) (j) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne s County, 1996 Ed.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE S COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 21-12B(2) and (B) (2) (j) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne s County, 1996 Ed. be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

§21-12. Emergency Service Advisory Council.

...

(2) The County will appoint 13 voting members of the Council. Voting membership will include representatives as follows:

...

(j) Consumers (3).

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Ordinance shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment and shall only apply to open space lands annexed after the effective date hereof.
