Navigating Your CSS Account

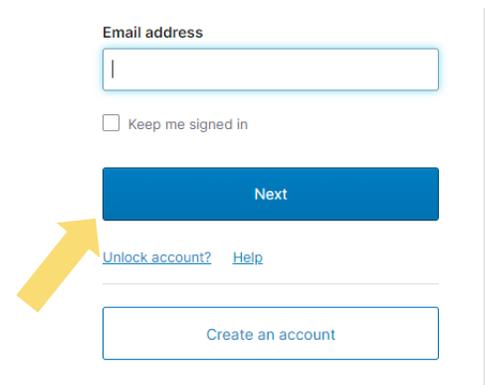

The Queen Anne’s County’s online Citizen Self Service Portal, CSS, will allow you to submit applications for various county services. In this guide, we will explain how to navigate your CSS profile.

1. Navigate to the [CSS homepage](#) and click the “Login or Register” link in the top right of the screen.



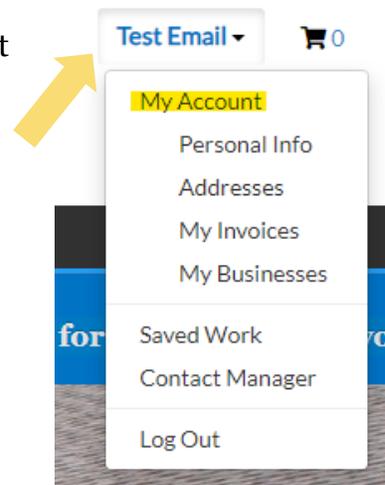
2. Enter your account email address and click “Next.”



3. Once logged into your CSS profile, select your account name in the upper right corner of the screen and select “My Account.”

There are 4 tabs to navigate within your account

- a. Personal Info
- b. Addresses
- c. My Invoices
- d. My Business

3a. From the “Personal Info” tab, you can modify information such as your name, contact information, business information, and contact preference.

3b. From the “Addresses” tab, you can add additional addresses to your profile as well as modify your main address.

** Please be sure to double check the address before saving to it your profile. **

3c. From the “My Invoices” tab, you will be provided a list of all outstanding and paid invoices generated in the system using your contact information.
