

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO
COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 01-08

A BILL AMENDING

AN ACT CONCERNING the Repeal and Readoption with Amendments of Sections 4-101, 4-102 and 4-103 of Title 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County (1996 Ed.) entitled "Board of County Commissioners" by amending proposed Section 4-101(a) of County Ordinance 01-08.

FOR THE PURPOSE of providing that the Commissioner who is not elected from a County Commissioner District shall hold the position of President of the County Commissioners for the first year of the term and thereafter the President of the County Commissioners shall be elected by majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED by the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, Maryland that Section 4-101 (a) of pending County Ordinance 01-08 be amended to read as follows:

4-101. County Commissioners; number; election; tenure.

(a) Number.

There shall be 5 County Commissioners for Queen Anne's County, 4 of whom shall be elected at large, with 1 residing in each of the 4 County Commissioner Districts of the County. The fifth shall hold the position of President of the County Commissioners FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF HIS OR HER TERM, may reside in any area of the County and shall be elected at large. FOLLOWING THE FIRST YEAR OF THEIR TERM, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL ANNUALLY BY MAJORITY VOTE SELECT ONE COMMISSIONER TO SERVE AS PRESIDENT OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
