

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 98-07

**A BILL ENTITLED**

AN ACT CONCERNING the Repeal and Re-Adoption with an amendment of Official Zoning Map 57 of the Queen Anne's County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations.

**SECTION I**

FOR THE PURPOSE of correcting a mapping mistake related to the zoning district boundary line of Parcel 5, owned by Thomas C. Tanner, et al., located on the southeast side of Cox Creek, Queen Anne's County and the State Highway Administration right-of-way located on Parcel 5.

**SECTION II**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that the Queen Anne's County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations Official Map 57, revision enacted July 1, 1997, be and is hereby repealed and the attached Map Number 57 be and is hereby adopted as the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations Official Map Number 57 for Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

**SECTION III**

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth day following its passage.
