AN AMENDMENT TO
A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Repeal and Re-enactment with Amendments of Title 10, Section 10-107 of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County (Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), Queen Anne's County Ordinance No. 96-10.

FOR THE PURPOSE of amending a bill providing for revising provisions respecting membership of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board and establishing the composition and terms of the members of the Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board.

SECTION I. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Bill 96-10 is amended so that Section 10-107 thereof reads as follows:

10-107. Plumbing Board.

The County Commissioners shall appoint a County Plumbing Board which shall consist of five (5) members made up of one (1) representative of the Master Plumbers Association of Queen Anne's County and one (1) person holding a Master Plumbers license for Queen Anne's County who shall be recommended but not necessarily be a member of the Master Plumber's Association of Queen Anne's County, one (1) person employed in the building or construction industry who shall not be a plumber and two (2) persons not connected with the plumbing or building trade. Initially, the County Commissioners shall appoint two (2) members for one (1) year terms, Two (2) members for two (2) year terms and one (1) member for a three (3) year term. Thereafter all members shall be appointed for three (3) year terms or until their successor be duly appointed.

The Queen Anne's County Plumbing Board shall meet at least once a month at the office of the Plumbing Board or such other place as may be designated by the Board. In addition to the other duties hereinafter set forth it shall hear and decide all questions in dispute between property owners, or their agents, and the plumbing inspector. Said County Plumbing Board shall also act as advisor to the County Commissioners with respect to the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this law. Any person, firm or corporation aggrieved by the decision of the County Plumbing Board may appeal to the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's County
