

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on January 6, 2015, Commissioner Anderson introduced County Ordinance No. 15-01, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Revisions to the Queen Anne's County Animal Control Ordinance, Chapter 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland; FOR THE PURPOSE of providing for animal control functions in Queen Anne's County to be under the direction of a Department of Animal Control; removing the Sheriff of Queen Anne's County from supervision, direction or other involvement in animal control in Queen Anne's County; redesignating the "Director" of Animal Control as the "Manager" of Animal Control, and generally revising and updating the provisions relating to animal control in the Queen Anne's County Animal Control Ordinance; BY AMENDING Sections 9-2, 9-4, 9-5, 9-9, 9-10, 9-20, 9-22, 9-25 and 9-28 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, January 27, 2014 at 7:45 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes each. Written testimony of any length may be submitted on or before the hearing date to the County Commissioners, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland 21617.
