

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on June 14, 2016, Commissioner Moran introduced County Ordinance No. 16-08, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING the Applicability of the Queen Anne's County Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance; FOR THE PURPOSE of amending Chapter 28 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Adequate Public Facilities, to provide that a determination of adequacy of schools is required with respect to any preliminary plan or multifamily site plan which proposes seven or more new lots or units; making the Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance consistent with the Queen Anne's County Zoning Ordinance so that no adequacy determination with respect to schools is required for all minor subdivisions; and generally revising the provisions on Adequate Public Facilities in Queen Anne's County, Maryland. BY AMENDING Section 28-4 A. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.
