

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on July 26, 2016, Commissioner Anderson introduced County Ordinance No. 16-14, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING the Archeological Resource Investigations in Queen Anne's County; FOR THE PURPOSE OF requiring the documentation and preservation of archeological sites in Queen Anne's County, establishing criteria for preservation of archeological resources; providing for the applicability of these provisions and establishing a Development Review Process in connection with the approval of certain applications. BY RETITLING ARTICLE XVI of Chapter 18:1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County and ADDING a new Section 18-1-91.1.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, February 28, 2017 at 6:45 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland. The Queen Anne's County Planning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation with respect to the proposed proposal provided certain amendments are made.
