

COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 14-01

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING the Prohibition of Certain Clauses in Procurement Contracts.

FOR THE PURPOSE of prohibiting County procurement contracts from containing any clause which requires a party to participate in, or offer a bonus or preferential treatment to a party who participates in, a project labor agreement; and generally relating to procurement contracts in Queen Anne's County.

BY ADDING Section 4-13.1 to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County.

SECTION I

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND that a new Section 4-13.1 Procurement Contracts – Prohibited Clause be added to the Code of Public Local Laws to read as follows:

§4-13.1. Procurement Contracts – Prohibited Clause.

No procurement contract may include a clause that requires a party to participate in, or offers a bonus or preferential treatment to a party who participates in, a project labor agreement in which a party must adhere to obligations concerning union referral, union security, or collectively bargained compensation or benefits.

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
