

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on July 8, 2014, Commissioner Dumenil introduced County Ordinance No. 14-03, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Electronic Signs in Queen Anne's County, Maryland; FOR THE PURPOSE of allowing electronic signs in Queen Anne's County subject to certain limitations; regulating the size, frequency of message changes, types of signs and maximum illumination, of electronic signs; and generally adopting provisions for the allowance and regulation of electronic signs; BY ADDING a new Section 18:1-81 A. (13) to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. The Queen Anne's County Planning Commission has made a favorable recommendation with respect to the proposed Ordinance and has recommended an Amendment thereto.

The County Commissioners hereby give notice that a public hearing will be held on the Ordinance on Tuesday, August 26, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, The Liberty Building, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland.

Speakers will be limited to three minutes each. Written testimony of any length may be submitted on or before the hearing date to the County Commissioners, 107 North Liberty Street, Centreville, Maryland 21617.
