

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on June 24, 2014, Commissioner Moran introduced County Ordinance No. 14-11, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Impervious Surface and Transferable Development Rights in the Suburban Industrial District; FOR THE PURPOSE of increasing the impervious surface ratio in the Suburban Industrial (SI) zoning district in designated growth areas outside of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area and repealing the provisions for increasing impervious surface ratio in growth areas in the SI district through the use of transferable development rights; BY AMENDING Section 18:1-23 E. (2)(a)[1] and REPEALING Section 18:1-23 E.(2)(a)[2] of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

The Planning Commission made a favorable recommendation with further recommendations with respect to the proposed Ordinances.
