

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At their regular meeting held on August 12, 2014, Commissioner Moran introduced County Ordinance No. 14-14, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING Residency Requirements for Membership on the Queen Anne's County Economic Development Commission; FOR THE PURPOSE of allowing non-residents of Queen Anne's County who own or are the principal of a business located in Queen Anne's County to be appointed to the Queen Anne's County Economic Development Commission; and dealing generally with residency requirements for boards and commissions in Queen Anne's County; BY AMENDING Section 4-10 B. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland.
