

PUBLIC NOTICE

At their regular meeting held on Tuesday, October 14, 2014, The County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County, following amendment, adopted County Ordinance No. 14-15, A BILL ENTITLED AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS CHAPTER (CHAPTER 30) OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY. FOR THE PURPOSE of providing for the recovery of response costs associated with the release of and response to hazardous materials by Queen Anne's County Volunteer Fire Companies and/or DES; defining certain terms, establishing rates to be charged for response costs; providing for collection and disbursement of cost recovery; providing for enforcement and conflict. BY AMENDING Chapter 30 to the Code of Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County, Maryland entitled "Hazardous Materials".

This Act shall take effect on the forty-sixth (46th) day following its enactment.
